

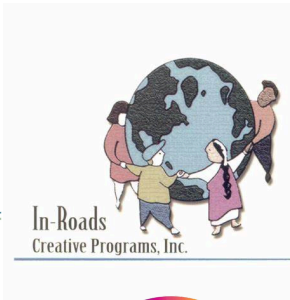


PURPOSE

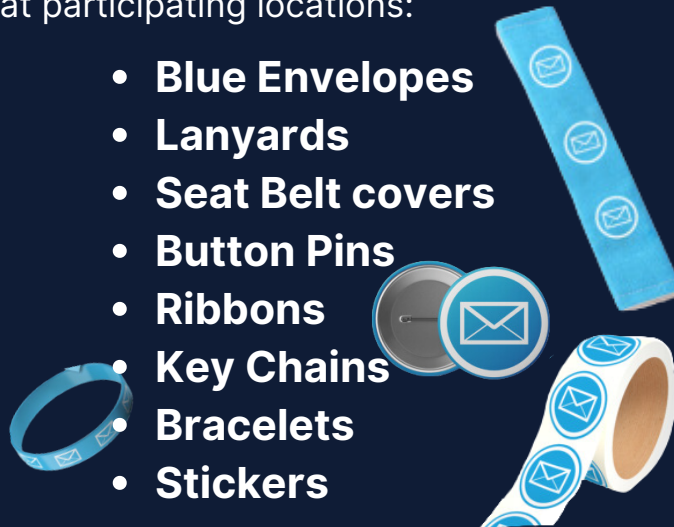
ABOUT THE BLUE ENVELOPE PROGRAM

The Upland Police Department is partnered with the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department, and both proudly offer the Blue Envelope Program. The program is designed to promote inclusivity and enhance awareness between law enforcement officers and community members diagnosed with a condition or disability, such as Autism Spectrum Disorder, dementia, anxiety, or other conditions, during law enforcement interaction.

HOW IT WORKS

The Blue Envelope Program works by allowing an individual to readily display the Blue Envelope logo or present a Blue Envelope upon contact with law enforcement or other community service personnel. The Blue Envelope-branded products can contain the individual's identification, contact information or pertinent vehicle operating documents such as the vehicle registration and proof of insurance.



The Blue Envelope Program does not have a registry component; therefore, the program is voluntary and self-implemented.
