

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Upland Memorial Park Revitalization Master Plan**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the City Council of the City of Upland will conduct a public hearing to consider a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Upland Memorial Park Revitalization Master Plan at a Special City Council Meeting on Thursday, June 10, 2021, at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chamber of the Upland City Hall, 460 North Euclid Avenue, Upland, CA 91786.

Due to the ongoing emergency concerning the COVID-19 Coronavirus, public attendance at the City Council meeting will be limited to establish appropriate social distancing. A live audio broadcast of the meeting will be provided in the City Hall Courtyard to accommodate overflow attendance. To ensure public participation, public comments will be accepted through remote and in person participation. All interested persons are invited to attend this public hearing and express their opinions for or against the proposal. If you challenge this project, or the related environmental determination in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Upland, at or prior to, the public hearing.

This also serves as the City of Upland's (City) Notice of Intent to adopt an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Upland Memorial Park Revitalization Master Plan Project, prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), CEQA Guidelines, and local implementation procedures.

Name of Project: Upland Memorial Park Revitalization Master Plan

Project Location: The project site is located at 1200 E. Foothill Boulevard in Upland, California. The 40-acre park site is situated between Foothill Boulevard to the north and San Bernardino Avenue to the south, and by Grove Avenue to the east and Hospital Parkway to the west, further described as Assessor Parcel Nos. (APNs) 1046-21-01, -03; 1046-131-03, -04, -10; and 1046-183-01.

Lead Agency: City of Upland, 460 N. Euclid Avenue, Upland, CA 91786

Project Description: Upland Memorial Park comprises 40 acres and currently offers baseball/softball fields, basketball court, picnic tables/shelters, a skate park, barbeque facilities, a day care center, band shell, a playground and parking. Proposed improvements include, but are not limited to, a new children's playground area, new central greenbelt and outdoor amphitheater, new splash pad, new open turf grass play area, new picnic areas, multi-use recreational facility, new multi-sport playfield, new expanded parking area, new landscaping, renovation of existing features and facilities, and supporting infrastructure upgrades.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration is based on the finding that, by implementing the identified mitigation measures, the project's potential significant adverse impacts will be reduced to a

less than significant level. The reasons to support such a finding are documented by an Initial Study prepared by the City. Copies of the Initial Study, the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and supporting materials are available for public review at the following locations:

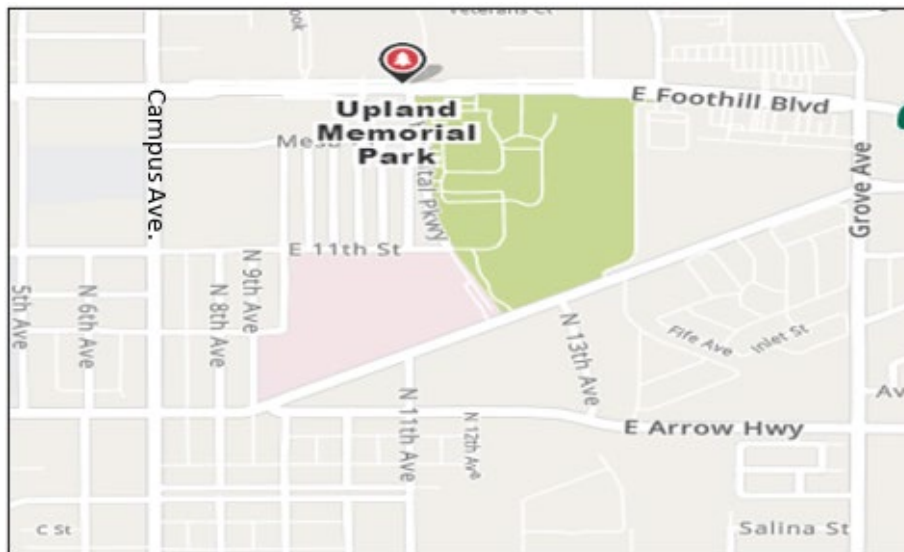
