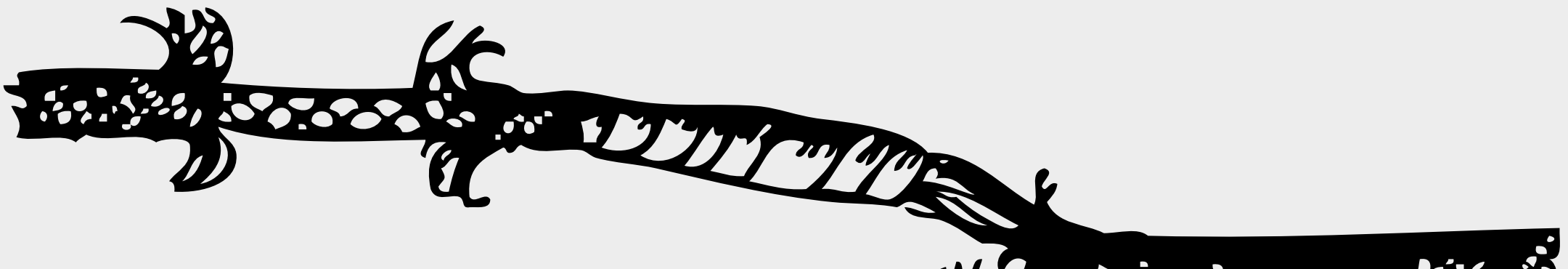
Anchor heavy objects such as your TV, fridge, shelves, and make sure your water heater is strapped

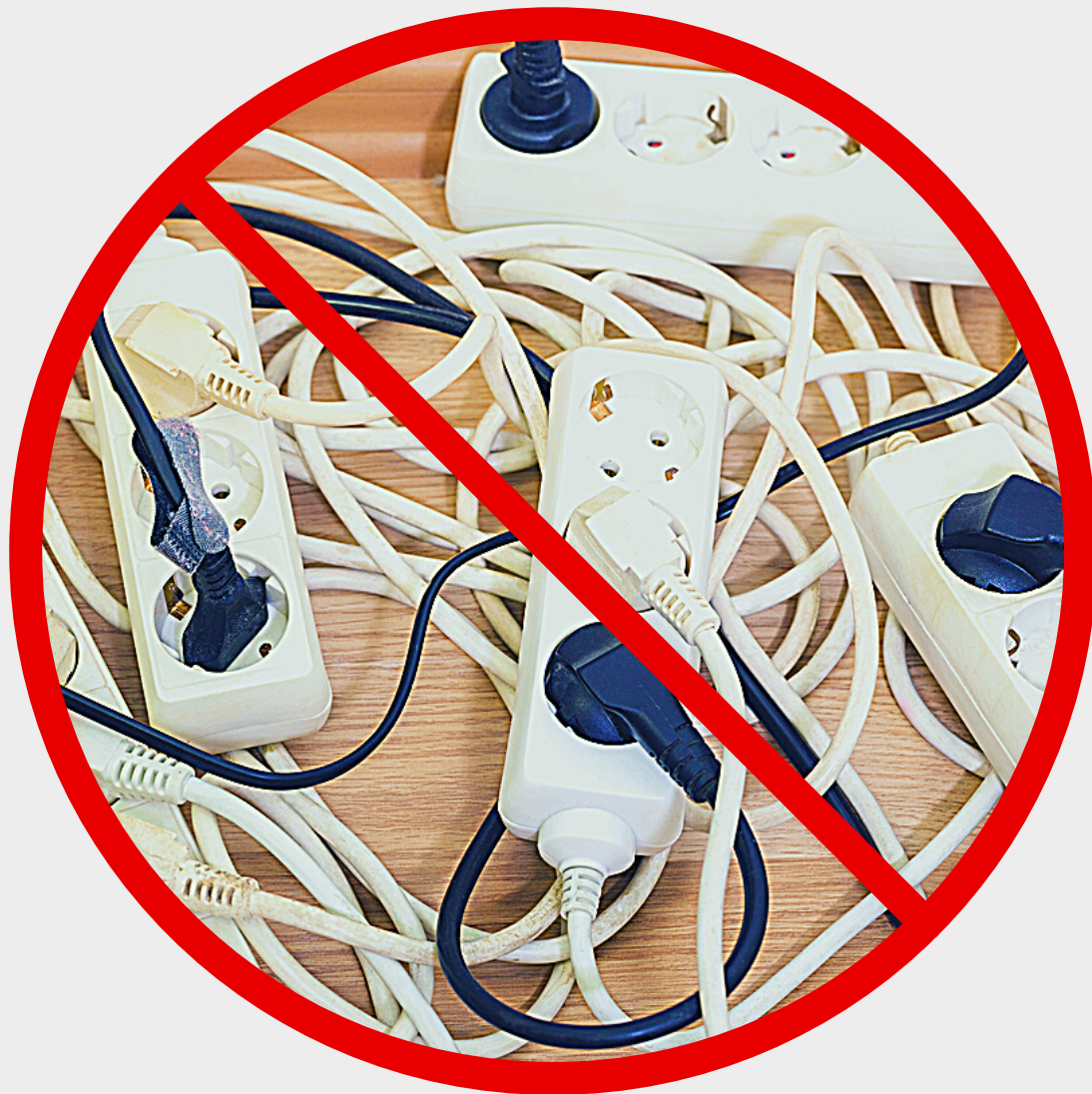


Replace

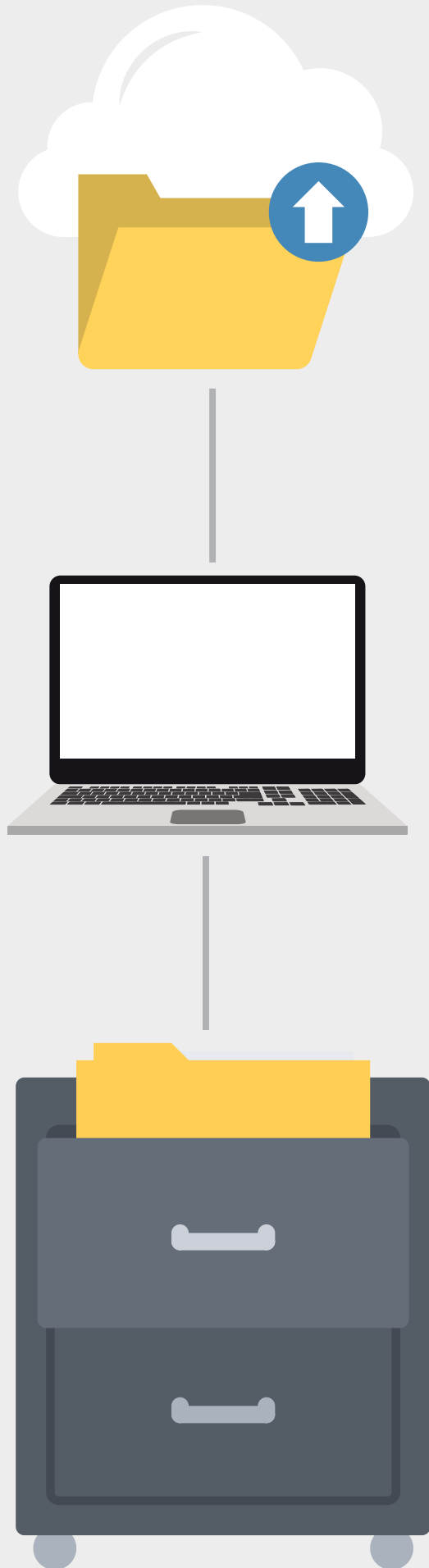

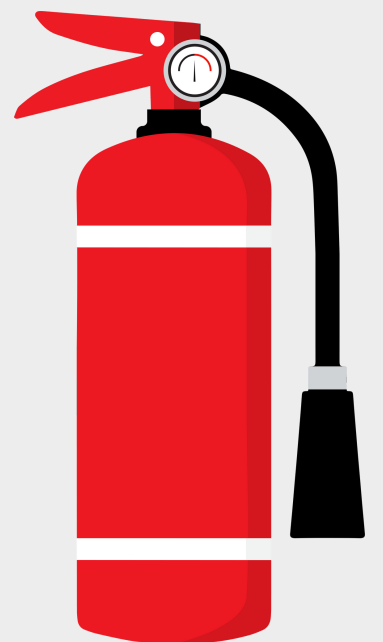
