A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

B. BIENNIAL REVIEW OF CITY'S CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

Adopted Resolution No. 6570 rescinding Resolution No. 6468 in its entirety and adopting a conflict of interest code applicable to designated positions, including members and staff of the Successor Agency to the Upland Community Redevelopment Agency, Upland Public Financing Authority, and Successor Agency to the Upland Housing Authority.

14. BUSINESS ITEMS

A. AWARD OF BID FOR PROJECT NO. 7071 & 7080, CITYWIDE CONCRETE REPAIRS (BID NO. 2020-04)

Interim Public Works Director Nix presented the staff report, which is on file in the City Clerk's Office. He then answered questions posed by the Council regarding the prioritization of areas to be repaired and the choice of contractor.

Motion by Councilmember Zuniga to approve the specifications for Project No. 7071 & 7080; award the construction contract to C.P. Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$629,270.00; and, authorize a construction contingency in the amount of \$62,730.00, for a total amount of \$692,000.00 from the Gas Tax Fund, seconded by Councilmember Velto, and carried unanimously.

15. ORAL COMMUNICATION (items not on the agenda)

Natasha Walton, urged the public to vote no on Measure Q and stated that park land is an important resource that cannot be replaced.

Tommy Brooks, urged the public to vote no on Measure Q and stated that there are no alternative baseball fields if the existing ball field is removed.

Stephen Larson, Upland, stated he is Chief Goodman's attorney and referred to a letter he sent to the Council regarding the Police Chief.

Lois Sicking Dieter, stated that the Council's discussion of potential Memorial Park improvements should not be conducted before the election and asked residents to vote no on Measure Q.

Ralph Cavallo, Upland, requested the Council clarify that sufficient funds will be provided to replace the baseball field in Memorial Park in the event that the land is sold.

Carlos Garcia, Upland, spoke in support of Chief Goodman and the Police Department, stating that crime has gone down since Goodman has been Chief.

Marjorie Mikels, stated opposition to the sale of park land.

Steve Bierbaum, Upland, spoke in support of Chief Goodman and the Police Department and stated the City is only as good as its police department.

Cindy Phillips, spoke in support of police Chief Goodman and stated that as a woman, she feels safer in the City.

City Manager Hoerning announced upcoming City events and reminded residents to participate in the 2020 Census.
