



## COVID-19 FIELD INSPECTION GUIDANCE AND MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

**The City of Upland is committed to the safety and well-being of its residents, contractors and Building and Safety Inspection Staff.**

These guidelines are for the safety of our inspectors as well as contractors, workers and homeowners performing construction work within the City's incorporation limits.

The City of Upland asks for your cooperation in keeping all of us safe during these challenging times. Please do your part by providing a safe environment for the inspector at all times while performing the inspection. Your inspector will exercise good judgment, common sense, and communicate with you during the inspection as best as possible within the minimum requirements shown below.

1. Social distancing guidelines WILL be observed at all time. **No exceptions.**
2. The Inspector WILL avoid all physical contact with others and require contractors, workers and homeowners to provide personal space of at least six (6) feet. Where required inspections are in a confined area, the Inspector WILL permit only contractors, workers or homeowners to be present he deems necessary to perform the inspection. **No exceptions.**
3. If required social distancing cannot be provided or if contractors, workers or homeowners do not comply with social distancing requirements, the Inspector, using his good judgment, may elect to terminate the inspection. **No exceptions.**
4. The Inspector MAY use facial coverings and gloves except where required by Orders issued by the San Bernardino County Health Department.
