What is the COVID Compliant Business Partnership Program?

To support local small businesses and ensure ongoing compliance with State and County Health orders and guidelines



How much funding can I apply for?

Businesses that meet small-business requirements: **\$2,500**

Businesses owners with additional eligible locations in the County will receive **\$1,000** for each additional location

Short Term Rentals (STRs) can receive support of **\$500** to offset basic costs of safety improvements and increased sanitization requirements. Any additional STR under the same owner would be eligible for an additional **\$250** each

All non-profits with a storefront or physical space are now eligible to participate

Sole Proprietors (0 employees) are now eligible if there is a corresponding retail space or storefront

Home-based businesses that service customers are now eligible (example: Home daycare centers)

What is the difference between the COVID Complaint Business Partnership Program Only and Small Business Funding?

All businesses that apply and determined to be a COVID Compliant Business Partner will:

- Be issued a "This Business Partner is COVID Compliant" window graphic
- Gain exclusive access to purchase PPE at County cost

Small businesses that meet the eligibility requirements will receive funding
