NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Upland, California, will conduct a public hearing in the Council Chamber, at City Hall, 460 N. Euclid Avenue, in the City of Upland, on Monday, July 13, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., to consider the Draft Permanent Local Housing Allocation (PLHA) Program Application and adopt and ratify a resolution approving the PLHA Plan.

The PLHA program, funded by the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD), provides grants to local governments in California for housing-related projects and programs that assist in addressing the unmet housing needs of their local communities. In order to receive PLHA funds, the City is required to submit a five-year PLHA Plan detailing the manner in which allocated funds will be used and compliance with program requirements.

The City of Upland is estimated to receive \$1,667,022 for the five-year period. Based on stakeholder input and City department review, the City is proposing the following activities:

1. Homeless Assistance Services
2. Affordable Rental Housing Acquisition and Rehabilitation
3. Administration
