## UMC 12.16.040 Swimming pool discharge into streets.

No person shall discharge swimming pool water into any public street, storm drain or natural water course without the written permission of the City Engineer. Said permission may be obtained by written application to the City Engineer stating the date on which the discharge may occur, together with the time and the expected point of discharge. In the event that the applicant expects to use a natural watercourse which is not owned by him or which is not in the public domain, the applicant shall show the written consent of the owner to said discharge. The City Engineer may require such other information as he deems necessary from time to time as a condition to the granting of said applicant, and may impose such conditions as he may deem necessary which will be in the best interest of the City and the persons down stream from the discharge. The City Council may fix a fee for the discharge permit from time to time by resolution. (Ord. No. 1218, § 3, 9-17-79)
